The last words a person says are significant. The person is using what strength they have left to express what is on their heart. When Jacob was on his deathbed, he called his sons to him and gave a prophecy regarding each son. When he came to Judah he said,

“The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh comes; and unto Him shall the gathering of the people be.” (Genesis 49:10). Shiloh is a reference to the Messiah, Jesus Christ, the Prince of peace (Isaiah 9:6). The word Shiloh in
