THE BRIGHT AND MORNING STAR

Revelation 22:16, "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, the Bright and Morning Star." Stars are used in the Bible to describe angels (Job 38:7), soul-winners (Daniel 12:3), and even false teachers (Jude 13) but how does the title Morning Star help to describe Jesus? The morning star is the announcer of the dawn, shining brightly at the end of the night and the beginning of the day. It was the first and the last. The morning star symbolized hope because it meant the darkness was ending. Jesus is our hope (1 Timothy 1:1). The morning star was also a symbol of joy because of its beauty. Jesus is the source of true joy (John 15:11). The morning star symbolizes direction and guidance. Sailors charted their paths by the stars and used the morning stars to check their course and position which would calm their fears. Jesus gives direction to mankind on the way they should go and calms our fears (Psalm 32:8 & Isaiah 41:10). Jesus is our Bright and Morning Star!
